Assistant Principal

As you may be aware, we recently advertised the position of Assistant Principal vacated by Ms Natalie Hill and completed a merit selection panel process as per DEC guidelines. I am pleased to announce that as a result of this rigorous process, we have offered this position to Mr Shannon Egan. Mr Egan has accepted this position and pending the ten day appeal process as per DEC guidelines, will be appointed to this position. Mr Egan will become the 3/4 class teacher later this year and also an Assistant Principal at our school. Mr Egan currently works at Bowral P.S and has previously worked at Bourke P.S. Mr Egan is currently fulfilling an important role at Bowral P.S as a Reading Recovery teacher and as a non teaching Assistant Principal mentoring staff and so an actual start date at Hill Top P.S for this year is still being negotiated. 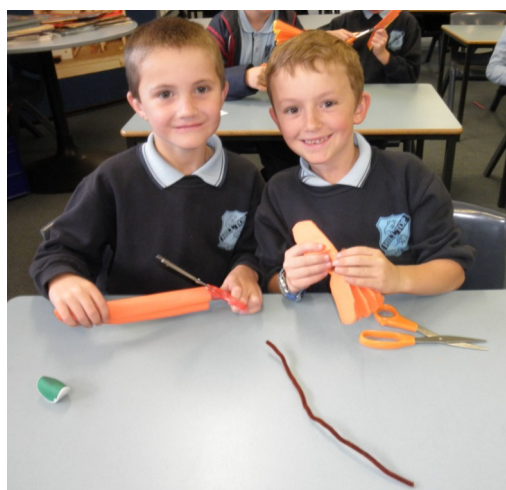
