Tomorrow, Thursday September 6 will be a busy day at Hill Top Public School. Gymsports for Schools—Next Term

Next term we are fortunate to have Gymsports visiting our school to deliver a five week gymnastic oriented movement program. The aim of this program is to provide an introduction to a developmental and sequential gymnastic movement program. All K—6 students are catered for as separate programs are implemented for each stage of a child's development. Gymsports usually provide a ten week program. We thought it best due to cost and other factors to trial an introductory five week program next term and then encourage school community appraisal and discussion in terms of success for possible future years involvement. 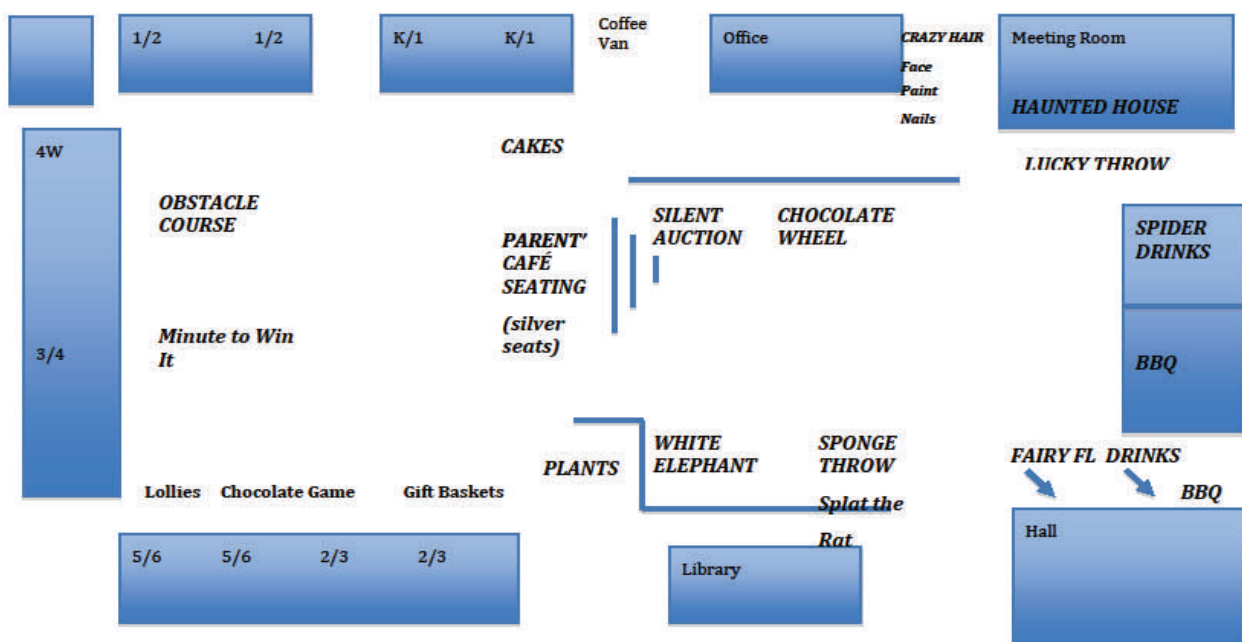
Year 6 Raffle

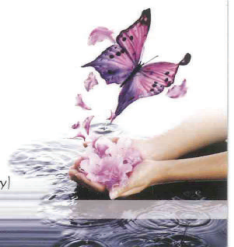
