Gymsports

Dear Parents,

Next term we are fortunate to have Gymsports visiting our school to deliver a five week gymnastic oriented movement program. The aim of this program is to provide an introduction to a developmental and sequential gymnastic movement program. All K—6 students are catered for as separate programs are implemented for each stage of a child's development. Each week students will participate in a 30 minute session and will use the four main apparatus including Bars, Beams, Floor and Vault/mini-tramp. Students will also use other equipment such as balls, ropes, hoops and ribbons to supplement the program.

Two experienced, trained coaches will run the sessions each week with the classroom teacher.

Each session will cost \$4.00 per child (\$20 for the whole program). Large family concessions are available. The 3rd child is half price and the 4th child is free so the maximum any family would need to pay is \$50. The sessions will run on a Wednesday in weeks 1, 2, 4, 5 and 6 of Term 4. Students can pay each week or they can pay the total amount at the front office in week 1.

We are looking forward to this exciting program next term.
